



DEMOGRAPHICS



There are two components to YouthLink:

- **Diversion**, which prevents youth from entering the homeless system.
- **Systems Navigation**, which connects youth to housing programs.

In 2023, **1,298 unique individuals** contacted the Youth line **8,508 times** through text or call.
